

MEMBERS CODE OF CONDUCT

As a member of the Jandakot Jets Senior Football Club (the club), you will uphold the Perth Football League members Code of Conduct.

Members will represent themselves in an honest manner and without bringing the Club or the game into disrepute.

- 1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all individuals within the context of their involvement in Australian Football and refrain from any discriminatory practices based on race, religion, ethnic background or special ability / disability.
- 2. Abide by the Constitution, policies and practices of the Club and the PFL.
- 3. Be supportive at all times and refrain from personal abuse or unnecessary physical contact with team members and opposition players.
- 4. Foster respect for umpires, opponents, coaches, administrators, other officials, parents, spectators, sponsors and the Jandakot community.
- 5. Reject the use of performance enhancing substances in sport and will abide by the guidelines set for the in the AFL Drug Policy.
- 6. Abide by the Clubs Smoking Policy by smoking in designated smoking areas only.
- 7. Recognise and abide by the responsible consumption of alcohol policies according to the Club, PFL and Liquor authorities. All drinking of alcohol is banned outside the licensed area and will be policed.
- 8. Act responsibly in consuming alcohol and do not create unnecessary risks that create a threat to other members, spectators, opponents and the community. This includes being responsible for noise levels when leaving the ground after games and training.
- 9. Respect and not willfully damage or remove (without permission) the property of the Club and that of other Club members or opposition members.
- 10. Be conversant with the PFL expectations and Code of Conduct.
